The inaugural **Advancing Milling & Nutrition Conference**, in conjunction with **Recent Advances in Animal Nutrition – Australia (RAAN-A)** and **Australasian Equine Science Symposium (AESS)**, is being held at Crown Melbourne 13-14 May 2025. The unity of multiple events under the one roof provides delegates the opportunity to move between sessions depending on their interests, whilst sponsors are exposed to delegates of all streams meaning increased exposure at no extra cost.

Australasian Equine Science Symposium

The two-day biennial **AESS Symposium** will be a scientifically focused forum for equine scientists and industry personal to advance knowledge in all aspects of equine science and associated aspects of horse management.

Submissions of short one page papers for AESS are open.

- Papers on all aspects of equine science, including nutrition, reproduction, genetics, disease, performance and welfare are welcome.
- Please note that all abstracts are to be submitted online only.
- All submissions will be peer-reviewed.
- All submissions require a brief biography of the presenting author as well as a photo (for the app). This is requested during the submission process.

Short Paper Guidelines

Short one-page papers must be original and not presented or published elsewhere. The content should be no more than 600 words in length (excluding the title, authors and affiliations). The paper must not exceed one page, including title, authors, affiliations and references.

Please include graphs and images in your submissions.

Short papers will be considered for both oral presentations (15 minutes) and speed talk (3 minutes) presentations. This decision will be made by the program committee based upon relevance to recent advances in equine science.

The closing date for submissions will be the **1st December 2024**
